

# Q&A: What is your current reason for living?

Thanks for the question. There will be a more complete answer when I write about the recent season of my life soon.

But the simple and quick answer is this: worship. My reason for living is to worship God.

Why? Beyond the fact that that is simply the Right Thing to Do... Building on the scriptural premise (to borrow the words of the Westminster Shorter Catechism):

*Q. 1. What is the chief end of man?*

*A. Man's chief end is to glorify God, [a] and to enjoy him for ever. [b]*

*[b]. Ps. 16:5-11; 144:15; Isa. 12:2; Luke 2:10; Phil. 4:4; Rev. 21:3-4*

... I have been very aware in the last while that God is the single constancy in life. All other values, purposes, ambitions, feelings and even relationships, while real and precious (even when difficult) are fleeting and unreliable.

In the end, the reason I live is because God, and God alone, is faithful.
